Higashi Chaya District: This is the largest of the three *chaya* entertainment districts in Kanazawa, and is as prestigious as the Gion district in Kyoto. With its stone-paved paths, red-painted wooden latticed facades, and gas lamps, walking through this district is like stepping back in time.

Kenrokuen Garden: Located just next to Kanazawa Castle, Kenrokuen Garden is reputed as one of the three best gardens in Japan for its scale and beauty, and is designated as a Special Scenic Spot by the National Government. 21st Century Museum of Contemporary Art: This museum is located at the center of Kanazawa City, and features a world-class collection of contemporary art works.

Omicho Market: Omicho Market is called 'the kitchen of Kanazawa citizens', and has about 180 stores offering fresh fish, fruits, vegetables, meat, prepared foods, sweets and as well as all sorts of every day goods.
